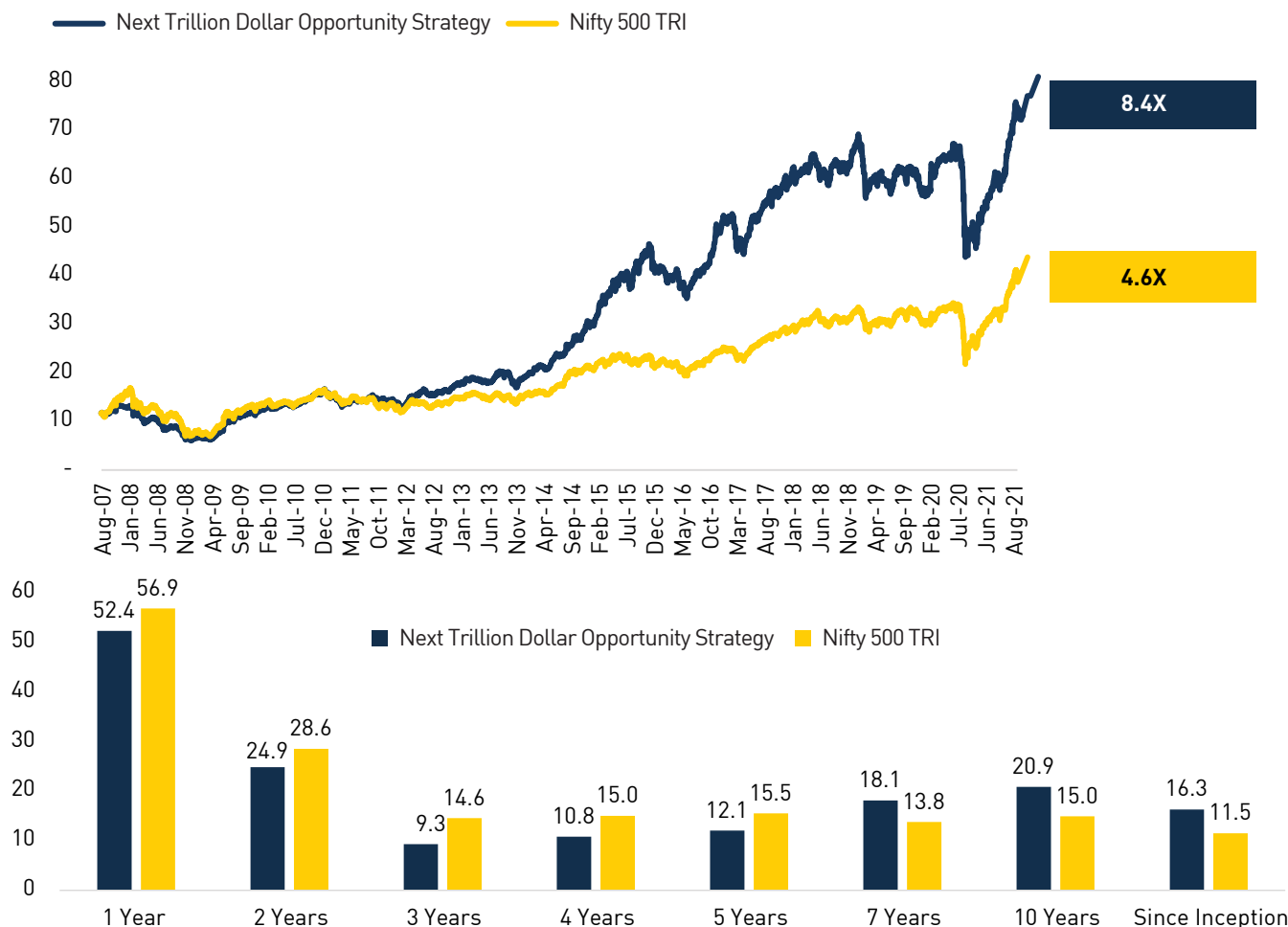

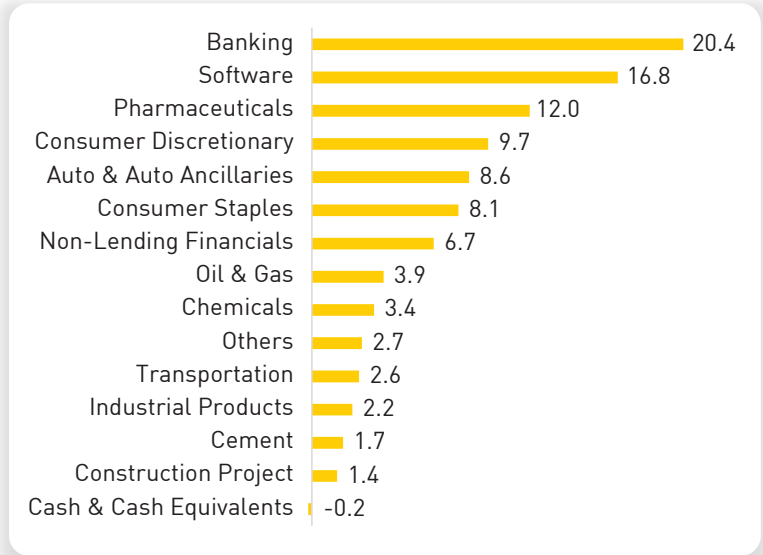
PERFORMANCE SINCE INCEPTION
